Stone Festival Committee have now been granted Road Closures, to protect those participating in two of their 2023 events (reproduced below):

(1) For the evening of Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> June, for the whole of Stone High Street, whilst the Two Wheel Tuesday event takes place.

This applies from 6pm until 9pm that evening. The Festival Committee will have stewards at the top of the High Street, to advise motorists and other users that the closure is in effect. Should anyone have a valid reason to access premises in the High Street that evening, the stewards will arrange for the vehicle to be escorted, slowly and safely, to and from the premises.

(2) For Carnival Day, Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> June, for Station Road, Granville Square, and the whole of the High Street.

Whilst the closure is valid from 10am until 4pm, the closures on Station Road and Granville Square will only be enforced for the minimum amount of time necessary to allow safe passage of the Parade from the car park of the St Dominic's Priory School (where it will depart at 11am) into the High Street.

The High Street is subject to traffic restrictions from 10am until 4pm every day. The requested road closure merely reinforces this restriction. Again, stewards will be on duty both at the top of the High Street, and in Mill Street, to help with access should any emergency arise. In the lower half of the High Street (below Mill Street) there will be a number of commercial and charitable stalls – set out in much the same way as stalls at the Farmers Markets.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the Borough Council of Stafford on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of May 2023 made an Order under Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847.

- 1 That between the hours of 6.00 pm and 9.00 pm on Tuesday the Sixth day of June Two Thousand and Twenty Three no persons shall drive or ride any motor vehicle, horse, cart, carriage, bicycle or any other vehicle of any description whatsoever along High Street and Mill Street (the 20-metre length of Mill Street from its junction with the High Street to Christchurch Way junction), Stone which streets are situated within the said Borough PROVIDED ALWAYS that this prohibition shall not apply to the driver of any vehicle directed by a Police Officer in uniform to proceed through the said street.
- 2 Alternative traffic routes will not be provided.
- 3 Any wilful breach of this Order shall be deemed a separate offence against the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 and any person committing any such offence is liable to a penalty not exceeding £1000.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the Borough Council of Stafford on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of May 2023 made an Order under Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847.

- 1 That between the hours of 10.00 am and 4.00 pm on Saturday the tenth day of June Two Thousand and Twenty Three no persons shall drive or ride any motor vehicle, horse, cart, carriage, bicycle or any other vehicle of any description whatsoever along Station Road (from Trinity Street to Granville Square), part of Newcastle Street/Radford Street (A520) (where it passes through Granville Square), High Street and Mill Street (from its junction with High Street and the Christchurch Way) which streets are situated within the said Borough PROVIDED ALWAYS that this prohibition shall not apply to the driver of any vehicle directed by a Police Officer in uniform to proceed through the said street.
- 2 Alternative traffic routes shall not be provided.
- 3 Any wilful breach of this Order shall be deemed a separate offence against the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 and any person committing any such offence is liable to a penalty not exceeding £1000.
